

SUBJECT: New Policy regarding Special Power of Attorney (SPA)



- 1.0 By way of **supersession** of **Advisory No. 010-2024** dated September 26, 2024, the Provincial Government has implemented a **revised** policy on the Special Power of Attorney (SPA) to ensure the accuracy and integrity of procurement processes.
- 2.0 Effective **October 15, 2024**, the SPA must indicate the **Invitation to Bid No. and Contract Name** which the authorized representative is participating in.
- 3.0 For the **purchase and submission** of bidding documents, all representatives acting on behalf of the principal must present an SPA to ensure proper authorization and validation. Failure to provide the required SPA will prevent the representative from purchasing or submitting bid documents.
- 4.0 All suppliers and contractors are advised to comply with these requirements to avoid delays in the procurement process.
- 5.0 For the information of all concerned.
