
TYPICAL COLUMN ELEV. SHOWING DOWELS AND TIES SPACING













TYPICAL CONNECTION DETAIL OF MASONRY WALL




TYP, DET. OF LINTEL BEAM AT CHB WALL OPENING










TYPICAL CHB FOOTING DETAILS (WHERE APPLICABLE)
