AN ORDER DECLARING THE 21ST OF JANUARY AND SUBSEQUENT FRIDAYS THEREAFTER INCLUDING THOSE IN THE MONTHS OF FEBRUARY AND MARCH OF 2022 AS PROVINCIAL VACCINATION DAYS

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that local governments units shall exercise powers for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare, including the promotion of health and safety of the people;

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Republic Act No. 11525, otherwise known as the "COVID-19 Vaccination Program Act of 2021," provides that the State shall adopt an integrated approach to health including vaccination to address the adverse impact of COVID-19;

WHEREAS, considering the goal to vaccinate at least 70% of the province's total population and the impending threat of Omicron and other COVID-19 variants, there is a need to collaborate among stakeholders of the province by forging unity and cooperation to intensify the ongoing vaccination program;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARC DOUGLAS IV C. CAGAS, Governor of the Province of Davao del Sur, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby ORDER the following:

SECTION 1. DECLARATION. In addition to the daily vaccination activities, the 21st day of January and subsequent Fridays of the week thereafter including those in the months of February and March of 2022 be set aside as "Provincial Vaccination Days."

SECTION 2. IMPLEMENTATION. For this purpose, the Provincial Health Office (PHO) is hereby directed to lead the observance of the "Provincial Vaccination Days."

The PHO shall collaborate with the provincial offices of the Department of Health, Department of the Interior and Local Government, Philippine National Police, Philippine Coast Guard, Philippine Army, Department of Trade and Industry, National Commission of Indigenous Peoples, Department of Education, private hospitals, the Philippine National Red Cross, local government units (LGUs), civil society and the private sector, among others, to enable active participation and secure necessary support and assistance for the effective implementation of these vaccination days.

Local Government Units of the province shall mobilize resources, stakeholders, human resources within their areas of jurisdiction to achieve the objectives of this endeavor.

All health workers, including doctors, nurses, midwives, pharmacists, dentists and medical technologists, are called upon to provide full support and cooperation in administering the vaccines on these days.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
