### Campaign Against Illegal Drugs

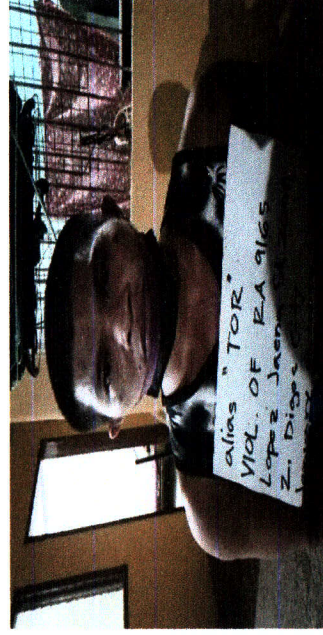
On January 6, 2022 at about 6:43 PM, personnel from City Drug Enforcement Unit (CDEU) and Intelligence Unit of Digos CPS led by **PLT ARTURO P PAPAS JR**, Officer of the Day conducted a joint Anti-illegal Drug “Buy-bust” operation at Lopez Jaena St., Brgy. Zone 2, Digos City together with the personnel from PDEU, PIU and PDEA Davao del Sur under the over-all supervision of **PLTCOL HAMLET M LERIOS**, Officer-In-Charge, Digos City Police Station which resulted in the arrest of **MARK ANTHONY EMBAC CAÑEDO** alias “Pawiks/Tor”, 31 years old, male, married, Catholic, market laborer and a resident of Dato’c Riverside, Brgy. Zone 1 Digos City..

Pieces of evidence recovered from the possession and control of the suspects, including the buy-bust items, are listed below:

- a. One (1) pc. heat-sealed transparent plastic sachet containing white crystalline substance believed to be shabu (Buy-bust item);
- b. One (1) pc. heat-sealed transparent plastic sachet containing white crystalline substance believed to be shabu (possession item);
- c. One (1) pc. genuine One Thousand Peso bill (P1,000.00) bearing serial number AM824644 with initial marking “SCE” (marked money);
- d. Four Hundred Twenty Peso (Php 420.00) proceeds money in different denominations;
- e. One (1) pc. coin purse color dark blue; and
- f. One (1) unit Oppo cellular phone color gold.;

Buy-bust and possession drug items have an estimated weight of MOL 0.17 grams of suspected methamphetamine hydrochloride or “shabu” with an estimated DDB value of One Thousand Nine Hundred Sixteen Pesos (Php 1,156.00).

Digos CPS is now preparing the pertinent documents for the filing of appropriate charges against the suspects. Investigator on case is PSSg Joyce Chrysler D De Jesus with contact number 09488133349.

"Arman,"** male, 37 years old (October 31, 1984), fisherman and a resident of Purok Kitong, Brgy. Dawis, Digos City; **RONNIL FEROLEN a.k.a. "Baloy,"** male, 27 years old (July 26, 1994), painter and a resident of Purok 4, Brgy. Aplaya, Digos City; **JUAN GAYOLA PATEÑO a.k.a. "Johnny,"** male, 55 years old (February 5, 1966), self-employed and a resident of Purok Kitong, Brgy. Dawis, Digos City; **EDWARD BARBADILLO BULALA a.k.a "Gorilla/Dondon,"** male, 40 years old (Aug. 20, 1981) unemployed and a resident of Purok Bangus, Aurora Ext., Brgy. - Five (5) pieces cal.45 live ammunitions; and
- One (1) empty Mentos candy canister color blue;

Recovered from the possession and control of Alias Baloy:

- One (1) piece coin purse color yellow;
- Three (3) pieces of transparent sachet containing white crystalline substance believed to be shabu;
- One (1) unit cal.38 short firearm without ammunitions and without serial number; and
- One (1) piece coin purse color black;

Recovered from the possession and control of Alias Gorilla/Dondon:



Two (2) pieces transparent sachets containing white crystalline substance believed to be shabu. Other recovered evidences/items in the area:

- One (1) piece improvised tooter;
- One (1) unit small weighing scale color gray;
- One (1) disposable lighter color blue; and
- Cash amounting to two hundred twenty pesos (P220.00)

The arrested suspects as well as the pieces of evidence listed above were immediately brought to Digos CPS for recording and for proper disposition.

The arrested suspects will be brought to Davao del Sur Provincial Hospital (DSPH) for medical examination. The seized drug evidences together with the arrested suspects will be brought to Davao Sur Provincial Forensic Unit (DSPFU) located at Magsaysay St., Digos City for laboratory and drug test examination.

Buy-bust and possession drug items have an estimated weight of MOL 4.58 grams of suspected methamphetamine hydrochloride or “shabu” with an estimated DDB value of Thirty One Thousand One Hundred Forty-four (Php 31,144.00).

Digos CPS is now preparing the pertinent documents for filing of appropriate charges against the suspects. Investigator on case is PSSg Wenifredo B Baga-an Jr with contact number 09079264742.



### Campaign Against Illegal Gambling

On January 4, 2022 at about 5:30 PM, personnel of CIDG Davao Sur PFU11 (lead unit), personnel of Padada MPS led by **PLT RONALD D DITAN** under direct supervision of **PCPT CHRISTIAN C LUDGATE**, OIC and personnel of RFU11 Regional Special Operating Team (RSOT) conducted joint Anti-illegal Gambling Operation particularly illegal numbers game (LAST TWO) at Purok 2, Brgy. - b) one (1) dead fighting cock with gaff;
- c) one (1) live fighting cock;
- d) cash amounting to one thousand two hundred fifty pesos (1,250.00) used as their bet money;
- e) one (1) brown wallet; and
- f) one (1) cartridge case of gaffing paraphernalia.

The arrested persons were apprised of their constitutional rights in dialect known to and understood by them and now temporarily held at Sulop MPS for recording and proper disposition of his case.





