



- 3. DAMAGES TO ANY PURTION OF WORK BEFORE FINAL ACCEPTANCE EXCEPT DAMAGES DUE TO UNFORESEEABLE CAUSES BEYOND THE CONTROL OF AND WITHOUT FAULT OF NEGLIGENCE BY THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE REBUILT, REPAIRED AND RESTORED.


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TYPICAL ROADWAY SECTIONS


TYPICAL THRU FILL SECTION




